

## **EAT v4 NEWS**

### **Online Help manual is available**

8/8/2007

Online Help manuals are available from the EAT v4. There are 3 different manuals for different user levels. For coordinator and surveyor, they have all 3 manuals on the left hand side after login to the system. According to their role in the survey, the manual for that user level will be available after the selection of survey. For organisation user, there is only one help manual for both Organisation Administrator and Respondent.

### **Auto-save feature**

Under the Housekeeping menu, there is a new option called Auto-Save Status. You can click on this and select “Yes” or “No” to Enable this feature.

The Auto-save, when enabled (set to default Yes Auto-Save Status), will automatically save your most current EAT 4 data at 30 minute intervals. This will minimise the risk of losing your data when you forget to save while working in EAT 4.

Please note that Auto-save when enabled works on all EAT 4 screens except the Specialties, Clinical Indicators and Statistical Data screens.

### **Email acknowledgement**

30/6/2007

When you Submit your EAT 4 data, in addition to the EAT 4 screen message that your data has been successfully submitted, you will receive an acknowledgement email.

### **Ability to print single criterion**

There is a new “Report” icon on all EAT 4 criterion screens which enables you to selectively print the data only for the criterion you are working on.

### **“Clear” box in Summary of Supportive Evidence**

If you have ticked one of the “Yes/ WIP/ No” element boxes and wish to have the box blank instead, you can now tick the “Clear” box and the tick boxes for that element will revert to being blank.

### **Upgrade to existing Editor**

This will enable faster loading of the editor/ menu icons in general and fixes the double line spacing problem.

### **Report title in Survey Report has been modified.**

It will print according to the EQUIP phase.

### **Improved compatibility with MS Internet Explorer 7.**
